



## <u>Code of Conduct for Kingfishers Swimming Club:</u> Parents/Guardians

- 1. I will complete and return the Medical Information Form as requested by the club and provide details of any health conditions/concerns relevant my child on the Medical Form. I will report any changes in the state of my child's health to the coach prior to training sessions or events. I will ensure that the organisation has up-to-date contact details for me and for any alternative person(s) as required.
- 2. I will deliver and collect my child punctually at the start and end of training sessions/events. I will inform a club official or coaching staff if there is an unavoidable problem which will cause a delay in attendance or collection. If the club changes my child's lane and/or changes training session times, I will remember that the change is to provide appropriate levels of training and to enable my child to progress, and I should therefore support and encourage this at all times.
- 3. I will ensure my child is properly and adequately attired for the training session or event including all mandatory equipment, e.g. hats, goggles, etc.
- 4. I will inform the coach/welfare officer before a session if my child is to be collected early from a training session/event and if so, by whom.
- 5. I will encourage my child to obey the rules and teach them that they can only do their best.
- 6. I will show appreciation and support my child and all team members.
- 7. I will support the coach, club officials and club committee appropriately and raise any concerns I have in an appropriate manner through the club welfare officer.
- 8. I will not enter poolside unless in an emergency or requested to do so.
- 9. If I wish to have a discussion with the coach I will check with the welfare officer or club official/front of house reception team to arrange this.
- 10. Most of all I will encourage and support my child to do the best they can and to enjoy their sport.

## **Kingfishers Will**

1. Inform you at once if your child becomes ill and will ensure their wellbeing until you are able to collect him/her.





- 2. Ensure good child safeguarding guidelines are followed at all times to keep your child safe.
- 3. Ensure all activities are properly supervised/taught/coached and that consent is and obtained for any activity outside that previously agreed.

## You Have a Right To

- Make a complaint to the club or Swim England if you feel the club or a member of the club or Swim England is not acting appropriately or in accordance with Swim England/club rules and regulations. Details of how this can be done can be obtained from the club welfare officer.
- 2. Make a complaint on behalf of your child to the Swim England Office of Judicial Administration.
